

National Physician Survey, 2007. Results for Family Physicians/General Practitioners.

Q25b. Please indicate if there are other important access issues for your patients.

Among all Family Physicians: Twenty-six percent of respondents indicated other important access issues for their patients when given the opportunity. The issues most often indicated include: uninsured paramedical services (especially physiotherapy and mental health care), the shortage of family physicians, travel distance and expense for patients to get to appointments, the difficulty accessing advanced diagnostic services (e.g. MRI, CT).
