

National Physician Survey, 2007. Results for Family Physicians/General Practitioners.

Q6. Please specify the profession of your spouse/ partner.

Among all Family Physicians: Thirty-five percent of physicians with a spouse/ partner indicated their profession. Among them, the most frequently indicated professions were: health diagnosing and treating occupations (35%, with the most common being physicians/surgeons (21%) and nurses (8%)), homemaking or retired (13%), education/training/library and museum occupations (9%), management occupations (7%), architects/surveyors/cartographers (6%), business and financial operations occupations (5%).
