Q25b. Please indicate if there are other important access issues for your patients.

Among all Internal Clinical Specialists: Twenty-six percent of respondents indicated other important access issues for their patients when given the opportunity. The issues most often indicated include: lack of universal drug coverage, the shortage of family physicians, the shortage of hospital beds, shortage of internists.
