

National Physician Survey, 2007. Results for Clinical Specialists - other.

Q6. Please specify the profession of your spouse/ partner.

Among all Other Clinical Specialists (excluding Internal Clinical Specialists): Forty percent of physicians with a spouse/ partner indicated their profession. Among them, the most frequently indicated professions were: health diagnosing and treating occupations (36%, with the most common being physicians/surgeons (24%) and nurses (10%)), homemaking or retired (19%), education/training/library and museum occupations (10%), management occupations (7%).
